Bob Hilbert Sportswear Short Track Super Series Fueled By Sunoco

Belmont's Garage South Region Round No. 1

General Rules:

Minimum Weight:

All cars must weigh 2,350 lbs., post-race, with driver in car. *Track scale pounds.*

Tires:

Right-Rear: American Racer 53 or 56 compounds ONLY

Left-Rear: American Racer 44 compound ONLY

Right-Front: American Racer 44 compound ONLY

Left-Front: Any American Racer tire

**Any track or series stamp is permitted. No specialty or block tread tires. No softening or chemically altering tires.*

**Tires are subject to durometer and/or lab testing at any time.*

Qualifying:

Drivers will draw for assignments of Qualifying Race groups. Qualifying Race groups will hot lap together. Hot laps will be timed. Heat starting positions will be determined by hot lap times with an invert of the redraw positions: if the redraw is four (4), the fastest driver in each hot lap group will start fourth, with the fourth-fastest starting on the pole. Remaining starting positions will be "head's-up" based on time. Qualifying Races will be 12 laps in distance.

B-Mains (8 laps) will set the remainder of the field on Saturday, March 14.

Qualifying Race top transfers will redraw prior to the 40. Non-redraw qualifiers from Friday night fill in 'Head's-Up' with B-Main transfers and provisional starters behind them.

The two highest drivers in final 2025 STSS Sportsman Belmont's Garage South Region points unable to qualify will be eligible for provisionals (*half green money*).

Restarts in Qualifying Races and B-Mains will be double-file unless there are two caution flags on the same lap: at which point the restart will be single-file until another lap is scored. All starts and restarts occur in the Sunoco Race Fuels Start Zone. After the completion of one (1) lap, the leader may choose inside or outside. Lapped cars drop to the rear in the order they are running.

There is no penalty for introducing a back-up car prior to or after the completion of the Qualifying Races as a multi-day event.

Single-Entry Policy:

Drivers may only register once at this event. Multiple entries/draw attempts for one driver are strictly prohibited.

Race Format:

All 40 laps will be completed under green-flag conditions.

All starts and restarts will take place in the Sunoco Race Fuels Start Zone in Turn No. 4.

After the completion of one (1) lap, the leader has option of restarting on the inside or outside lanes.

Restarts will be double file through lap 34. In the event of back-to-back cautions before a green-flag lap is scored, a single-file restart will follow. Restarts will revert to double-file after the completion of a green-flag lap without an incident through lap 44. From laps 35-40, all restarts will be single file.

Drivers involved in a caution flag will be directed to the rear of the cars on their respective lap. Should a driver complete a 360-degree spin and continue without stopping and a caution flag is thrown, that driver will restart where they "blended in" within the running order.

Lapped cars will drop to the rear in the order they are running at the time of a caution flag. The top-running lapped car at the time of any caution will be waved around to the tail end of the lead lap via the 'Lap-Down, Go-Around' program.

Lead-lap cars returning to the track from the pit area will file in at the tail of the lead-lap cars, ahead of the lapped cars.

No driver should pass the Pace Vehicle without express permission on the one-way radio from the Race Director.

Drivers may not pit under red-flag conditions. Pits will be open under red/yellow or yellow conditions once the track is deemed safe.

The race may be deemed official following the completion of lap 20. Sunday, March 15 is reserved as a rain date.

Transponders:

AMB Transponders are required for the 'Speed Showcase 40' event. Please make sure transponders are fully charged for the event.

One-Way Radios:

One-Way Radios are **mandatory** with a frequency of 454.000 ONLY. Electronic, two-way team communication is prohibited.

Car Registration/Temporary Membership:

Car Registration is \$50 in advance (through March 6) and \$75 (March 7 through Race Day).

Point Distribution:

The 'Speed Showcase 40' operates on the 100-point structure toward the Belmont's Garage South Region.

Disqualifications:

Drivers who are disqualified forfeit monies earned and points accrued for said Short Track Super Series event. Drivers who are disqualified will receive DNQ points for said event. In the event of a disqualification, all drivers behind the DQ car will be moved up a position and will be compensated as such with points and payout.

Social Media Conduct:

Competitors on the Short Track Super Series are independent contractors compensated by the series via purse and point fund monies. Competitors are expected to uphold the integrity of this business relationship in all posts on social media. Any posts viewed as detrimental to the series, its officials, host facilities or marketing partners could result in a fine and/or suspension from competition on the series.

Contingency Decals:

To be eligible for payout and/or point fund monies, all cars **must** be outfitted with the following decals: Short Track Super Series, Sunoco Race Fuels and American Racer. Decals of any competing brands must be concealed during Short Track Super Series events.
